Dear Members and Friends of South Mecklenburg,

Go to the notes app on your phone, grab a sheet of copy paper, pull off a post-it note, open a spiral notebook, get out your diary, purchase a papyrus, or turn to the empty side of the envelope, but don't put it off for another day. In fact, it is a habit you should try to develop for each day. Write down ten things that are representative of good in your life. Is it your kid? Write the name down. Did you enjoy a few days of vacation? Write down the destination. Were you the beneficiary of an act of kindness? Put it in print. Did you do something for someone that brought you no profit but the smile of witnessing their joy? Mark it. Did you bake bread, plant flowers, or take a walk? Write it down. Did you hold your tongue instead of adding to the static noise of societal anger? Print that in bold letters.

Join us in an experiment this fall. Let's see if there is any truth in the notion that GOOD begets GOODNESS. If we are intentionally conscious of the good that has permeated our lives, will we be more inclined to be bearers of such good to others? Will we be more motivated to contribute to the common good? The Apostle Paul challenges us to "hold fast to what is good." Similarly, James offers this for us to ponder: "Who is wise and understanding among you? Show by your good life that your works are done with gentleness born of wisdom."

These pages highlight opportunities to embrace goodness in a variety of ways. Shall GOOD beget GOODNESS? Let's find out together.
