FROM OUR PASTOR

The final utterances of Jesus before his death were offered from a cross, a torturous tool constructed by the state for purposes of capital punishment. It is not a pulpit nor a context from which anyone would hope to offer a final word. Long gone were the crowds pushing to get close to Jesus as he taught at the seaside, on the mount, or along the way. Rather, outside the walled city built by the Chosen, Jesus looked down upon a scattering of soldiers performing their macabre duties, his disconsolate mother, and maybe a couple of courageous friends who if identified could well be hanging with him on death row. Keeping a low profile wasn't so difficult for them amidst the frenetic activity of the pilgrims who swelled Jerusalem's population throughout the holy season of Passover. In fact, to the foot traffic passing by, the figures hanging at Golgotha were only a sideshow, serving as a billboard for the Roman authorities, erected to remind the Passover crowd who truly held the reigns of power in the city of David.



Jesus' words from the cross are few, and yet essential. They provide flesh to the things Jesus said about love and self-giving. This Lent we will turn to the light these words offer to a broken world yearning for reconciliation — Know, Truth, Here, Forsaken, Thirsty, Finished, Commend. Alone, they are everyday words. In context, they frame the story of redemption and the incontrovertible power of mercy.


