Dear Members and Friends of South Mecklenburg,

At the conclusion of the Prelude each Sunday, one of the worship leaders will step forward to greet the gathered congregation with this prayer -- The Lord be with you. The congregation responds by saying -- And also with you. Similarly, as the children gather to process to children's worship, they, too, share in a prayer with the congregation. The congregation prays -- God be with you there.

Both of these blessings offer affirmation of the mutual fellowship we share in and through Jesus Christ. In scripture, this shared fellowship is understood to be the body of Christ. In 1 Corinthians, we read -- "Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it." 
REGISTER FOR THE ALL CHURCH SERVES FOR SMITHFIELD SCHOOL
