A young woman, unsettled by an encounter in the park and not ready to join the friends who wouldn't understand turns away from the party venue, and instead enters a dive bar across the street. "She's met by the smell of spilled beer, but no raised glances, the clientele just stare into their glass even when they speak to one another, it the sort of place where it's an act of mercy that there are no mirrors in the bathrooms." I came across this haunting quote in Fredrick Backman's novel, The Winners, and it struck me as illustrative of the lengths to which we will go or the depths to which we will fall to avoid the kind of honest self-evaluation that leads to the repentance, change, transformation, and work that returns words like hope, meaning, and purpose to our vocabulary.

Lent is the season for that very work — "The sacrifice acceptable to God is a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise." ... "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me." Telling the truth to ourselves may seem to great a risk, but it is in that truth that the God who loves us does God's best work. We invite you to join us during this season of self-evaluation/God-transformation called Lent, for, surprisingly, it is the journey to the cross that is the way to life.


